
THE COLLEGE EDGE



This program for **rising high school seniors** helps college-bound students develop a plan to prepare their college applications. Since many students struggle to begin collecting the components that make up the application packet, we'll get them started with their **college applications** and **essays**. Students will prepare an **activity list**, which can be turned into a **résumé** if they wish, for their application packet. In addition, they will organize all of their materials and information in an individualized **reference binder**. This program is designed for students who are **motivated** to work.

June and July sessions focus on completing the Common, Coalition, and individual applications, as well as the main college essay. (Course fee \$425)
